Council Meeting

No additions or corrections were noted. The minutes were approved as written.

Police Chief Shannon Hunt provided his monthly report and reported everything was going well. He stated the new speed signs from the T.H.S.O. grant were getting a good response.

Fire Chief Daniel Lafavor provided his monthly report. He advised the process for applying for an AFG grant for a new pumper had been started. It will be for approximately \$715,000 with a five percent local match.

The monthly financial reports were presented. No comments or questions were presented.

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In new business, Mayor Potts asked the Council to be thinking of an alternate date for the October Council meeting due to it falling on Columbus Day. He also advised that discussions regarding Date Centers had already begun taking place in the event it needs to be addressed.

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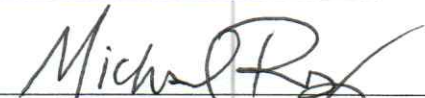
